

Annual Canaan Kids Club Box Car Event

Canaan Dirt Speedway is pleased to announce our Annual Box Car Night. It's open to "all" children. The Speedway will provide the boxes.

Entries will be judged in their Kids Club division in two categories: "**Best of Show**" and "**Direct Racing**". All young racing fans can construct a car.

The Rules:

A box car is a model car made out of cardboard. The sides of the box are painted to look like a race car. There is no bottom or top to the car. This is so a person can step into the box and lift it up so it can be raced "Flintstone Style". The size of the box car can vary, but it should be large enough that a person can race it and small enough that it can be lifted by one person. Cars must be constructed out of cardboard boxes provided by Canaan.

NO METAL OR WOOD ALLOWED.

The box car must have "Canaan Dirt Speedway Kids Club" displayed somewhere.

Each box car must have a car number on the side. Entrant's name and Kids Club division must be written somewhere on the car. Entrant must be able to lift the car without help. Cars should be designed in good taste; anything that the judges deem inappropriate will be removed from the competition. An example will be on display in advance of the contest.

Four Divisions of Racing for the Box Car event:

Mini-Stock	ages 4-6
Mod-Lites	ages 7-9
Sportsman	ages 10-12
Modifieds	ages 13-up

Direct Racing: Entrants for the racing portion of the competition will race against other entrants in their Kids Club division. Age groups will be determined based on participation. Each heat event will consist of no more than eight entries. The winner of each race will advance to the feature.

Best of Show: A panel of race fans will be selected to judge cars. There will be one winner in each division.
