CANAAN DIRT SPEEDWAY AMENDS HOOSIER TIRE RULE

Canaan Dirt Speedway General Manager, Dick Therrien has announced that they are amending the Hoosier Tire Rule to the following at Canaan Dirt Speedway: “The Hoosier rep told Jack from Northern Tires, that the numbers for the tires that were being sold range from 42-47 maybe 48 at best. I personally went to Chris Donnelly’s shop and measured ten tires last Saturday morning. The numbers ranged from 48 down to 44. The garage was 70 degrees and the tires were inside all night, stated Therrien. I feel it is in best interest of those racers that had purchased or have Hoosier Tires in their inventory be allowed to race them at Canaan in 2010. Being this late and with people already buying tires that were allowed prior to the rules upgrade, I am making this change for 2010. Please be reminded that this is for 2010 only, and this rule could very well change for 2011.”

HOOSIERS:

MAXIMUM TIRE SIZE 13 X 92.

MINIMUM DUROMETER READING ON HOOSIER CHAIN LINK TREADED REAR TIRES WILL BE “44 POINTS” MEASURED COLD. MAY BE TESTED RANDOMLY AT THE TRACK. NO HOOSIERS WILL BE SOLD BY CANAAN SPEEDWAY.

THE HOOSIER DIRT LEGAL D300 OR C3000 SERIES TIRES SHOULD MEET THIS REQUIREMENT. ALL TIRES DUROMETERED NEW DID REGISTER ABOVE 44 POINTS. PLEASE BE ADVISED THAT THE HOOSIER BLOCK TREADED TIRES MAY NOT MEET THIS MINIMUM REQUIREMENT, AND WILL NOT BE ALLOWED IF THEY DON’T.

PLEASE LET IT BE KNOWN THAT THIS NUMBER WAS AGREED UPON AS A FAIR NUMBER BY THE HOOSIER DEALER.
