

**NAPA / EASTMAN TROPHY CAR SHOW
SET TO ROLL ON SATURDAY, MAY 1ST**

The NAPA / Eastman Trophy Car Show for both the dirt and asphalt tracks at Canaan Fair Speedway is set to go on Saturday, May 1st at 10am. The show will be held on the asphalt track so that preparation may continue on the dirt track as both facilities will be practicing from 1:30-4pm, following the car show. Awards will be passed out at 1pm.

Here are the guidelines for the car show:

- 1. All cars must be on the track by 10am sharp.**
- 2. There are no points for the car show, but, all cars in attendance that participate in the car show will get to draw for starting positions for the following weeks openers on both track.**
- 3. If you do not participate in the car show, you will start behind the drivers that attended, even the rookies.**
- 4. Car does not have to be race ready to be in the show.**
- 5. Driver does not have to be in attendance, just the car. (Hopefully drivers will be with racecars so they can greet the fans!)**
- 6. Judging will be done by people with no affiliation to Canaan Fair Speedway or auto racing in general.**
- 7. Judging criteria includes: Cleanliness of car (inside and out), Neatness of lettering, paint schemes, extra graphics, etc.**
