Just a pair of cautions dotted the Papa Z's Sportsman Modified main event and Tom Forward picked up his first win of 2010 holding off a late race challenge by Allan Hammond. Dan Eastman grabbed the third spot followed by Trevor Rocke and Jason Sanville. Heat checkers flew for Nick Berry and Jim Lowery Jr.

Troy Comeau held off all challengers to grab his first win of the season in the Beard Sewer and Drain Super Streets. It was no easy task for Comeau as he was challenged all race by Will Hull who suffered mechanical problems with four laps remaining, and Jason Giguere who pulled along side with two laps remaining. Giguere settled for second, followed by Robbie Williams, Todd Buckwold and Ryan Christian. Hull picked up the qualifying win.

Josh Sunn, Chris Gray and David Dubeau thrilled the crowd as the trio dice for the lead the entire second half of the race before Sunn raced across the stripe for the win in the NAPA Mini Stocks. Gray raced home second ahead of Matt Morrill, Shawn Cunha and Dubeau. Dubeau scored the win in the heat race.

The Bond Auto Parts Bandits went green to checkers in their 15 lap main event. When it was all done, Dakota Stender picked up his second win of the season. Armond Boucher, Matt Boucher, Baxter Doty and Leon Dugan rounded out the top five. Qualifying wins went to Stender and Doug Boucher.
