**KEVIN CHAFFEE SCORES WIN IN TWIN STATE SERIES
OPENER AT CANAAN DIRT SPEEDWAY**

Another exciting night of racing on the dirt at Canaan Fair Speedway in Canaan, New Hampshire produced a surprise winner in the Gravco Janitorial, Jasper Engines Twin State Series for Sportsman Modifieds on Sherwin-Williams Paint Stores Night.

Kevin Chaffee muscled his way by Randy Howe on a lap 27 restart, and then held Howe off at the stripe to claim his first victory in the Mods at Canaan Dirt Speedway. In victory lane Chaffee was all smiles as he was so excited that he had beaten Howe at this facility where Howe has logged so many laps, and won so many races. Jason Sanville rolled home third, followed by Dan Eastman and Dave Sanville. Eighteen cars started the main event. Heat wins went to Ryan Avery, Howe and Gary Siemens.

Jason Giguere picked up the win in the Beard Sewer and Drain Super Streets. Giguere grabbed the lead with three laps to go, and held off a late charge by Ryan Christian. Troy Comeau, Robbie Williams and Todd Buckwold completed the top five. Williams walked away with the heat victory.

Once again the Napa Mini Stocks put on a tremendous race as Josh Sunn picked up another win. His arch rival, Chris Gray was right on his bumper for second. They were followed by Tim Hodge, David Dubeau and Mitchell Davis. Sunn also won the qualifying event.

Dakota Stender won another Bond Auto Parts Bandit event, but lost it in the tech line for having too much camber in his right front-end. This gave the win to Armand Boucher. Completing the top five were Alan Stender who was subbing for an ill Baxter Doty, John Thibedeau Jr., Chandra Lamery and Cody Dugan. Armond Boucher and Leon Dugan carried heat checkers.

The Q106 Granite State Mini Sprints were out in force on this night. Winning the 500c.c. class was Lacey Hanson. She was followed to the stripe by Larry Sheridan, Zachery Herbert, Troy Boissoneau and Joshua Boissoneau. Josh Boissoneau also won the heat race. The 600c.c. also put on a thrilling show as they were fifteen strong at the start. When the checkers flew, Brain Gray scored the popular win. He was followed by Johnny Chestnut, Luke Greenwood, Troy Boissoneau and Joshua Boissoneau. Heat wins went to Greenwood and Chestnut.

Canaan Fair Dirt Speedway will be back in action next Friday night, as there will be a full card of racing plus the NAPA Mini Stocks will go 25 laps paying \$200 to the winner.
