Dan Eastman broke to the front early after a side by side dual with pole sitter Michael Santaw. The pair raced hard for six laps before Eastman worked his way by out of turn two bringing Allan Hammond with him. Hammond set his sights on Eastman, but the handling went away, allowing Jason Sanville and Dave Sanville to race by in traffic. When the checkers flew, it was Eastman, Jason Sanville, David Sanville, Tom Forward and Russell Christian. Due to a bunch of mechanical problems, only one qualifier was held, and Michael Santaw claimed his first ever checkered flag.

The Beard Sewer and Drain Super Streets continued to impress the crowd again as the field continues to grow. Will Hull took the lead from Troy Comeau with two laps remaining to pick up his third win of the year. Jason Giguere also got by Comeau on the last lap to pick up the second place trophy. Comeau, Ryan Christian, and Robbie Williams rounded out the top five. Hull also pulled off the win in the heat race.

Tonight was the night that the NAPA Mini Stocks got to shine as they raced 25 laps with a \$200 payday waiting for the winner. Once again this highly competitive class thrilled the crowd lap after lap as they battled to the end. David Dubeau would be the winner, with Josh Sunn, Mitchell Davis, Cody Dugan and Josh Conners in tow. Sunn picked up the heat checkers.

Matt Boucher, Leon Dugan and Chris Cole battled each other for 15 laps in the Bond Auto Parts Bandits main event with Boucher hanging on at the line to pick up the win. Dugan and Cole were right on his rear bumper finishing second and third. The fourth spot went to Dakota Stender, and Armand Boucher completed the top five. Leon Dugan won the heat race.
