**FORWARD AND SHARP LEAD THE
WAY ON CANAAN DIRT**

The biggest crowd of the season witnessed another great night of action at Canaan Fair Speedway's dirt facility. Winners on the night included Tom Forward, Donnie Sharp, Ryan Christian, Mitchell Davis and Dakota Stender.

The Papa Z's Modifieds continue to impress as only two minor cautions dotting the event, one for a minor spin in turn two, and the other was for a medical emergency in the grandstands. Tom Forward raced by leader, Allan Hammond, with eight laps remaining, and then held off a late race challenge from Randy Howe to pick up the win. Howe, Hammond, point leader Dan Eastman and Toby Stark completed the top five. Heat checkers flew for Michael Santaw and Dan Eastman.

The Northeast Waste Service SCoNE 360 Sprints were out in force, and Donnie Sharp picked up his first win of the season outdistancing Kevin Chaffee, Chris Donnelly, Randy Howe, and Nick Berry. Dan Douville and Sharp collected heat wins.

The best race of the year occurred in the Beard Sewer and Drain Super Streets as the field battled hard the entire twenty lap event, with the lead changing nine times. When the dust settled, Ryan Christian scored a popular win over Jason Giguere, TC Forward, Troy Comeau and Todd Buckwold. Forward snagged the heat win.

The NAPA Mini Stocks saw a first time winner as Mitchell Davis jumped out front early and never looked back while the division hotshoes battled each other two and three wide the entire race. Second through fifth included Josh Sunn, David Dubeau, Jesse Durkee, and Brandon Durkee. Davis also claimed the victory in his qualifying round.

The Bond Auto Parts Bandits main event came to a grinding halt on lap 12 as leader Chris Cole had a major mechanical failure and crashed hard into the first turn wall. He was not injured, but the crash cost him a career first win. Dakota Stender outdistanced the field for the win. He was followed by Leon Dugan, Dallas Hammond, Armand Boucher and Alan Stender subbing for Baxter Doty. Heats wins went to Hammond and Dugan.
