

## **8/13/10 SANVILLE, COMEAU, SUNN AND DUGAN CRUISE TO WINS ON CANAAN DIRT**

The racing action continues to be red hot at the Canaan Dirt Speedway in Canaan, New Hampshire as the season races towards the end with just four point counting races remaining on the calendar. Winners on LaValley Building Supply night were Jason Sanville, Troy Comeau, Josh Sunn, Leon Dugan and Corey Robert.

Jason Sanville took over the top spot on a lap 19 restart from Allan Hammond and never looked back claiming the victory in the Papa Z's Modifieds main event. Hammond chased him to the stripe and held off a determined Dan Eastman to claim the second spot. Russell Christian and Toby Stark rounded out the top five. Michael Santaw and Hammond won their respective qualifiers.

The Beard Sewer and Drain Super Streets held a barnburner as Troy Comeau held off all challengers after race leader Ryan Christian broke a tie-rod on lap 18 handing the win to Comeau. Comeau was challenged to the line by Jason Giguere who was right on his rear bumper. Robbie Williams, Todd Buckwold and last week's winner, TC Forward completed the top five. Christian won the qualifying round.

Heavy attrition allowed Josh Sunn to run away and hide in the NAPA Mini Stock main event. Cody Dugan, Chris Cole, Leon Dugan and Tim Hodge made up the top five. Leon Dugan won the qualifying event.

Leon Dugan had a solid run in the Bond Auto Parts Bandits and was able to hold back Matt Boucher, Armand Boucher, Mike Stender and PJ Vaillancourt. Dugan also won a heat race along with Dakota Stender.

Corey Robert lapped the field in the 35 lap Enduro race. Mitchell Davis, Doug Boucher, John Thibedeau Jr., and Kevin Dickinson completed the top five.
