

8/20/10 BERRY, ROCKE AND FORWARD ON TOP AT CANAAN DIRT SPEEDWAY

The race fans and race teams left Canaan Fair Speedway buzzing, as Bond Auto Parts and Make-A-Wish presented a night of near flawless racing that kept everyone on the edge of their seats until the checkers flew. Winners on the night included Tunk Berry, Trevor Rocke, TC Forward, Josh Sunn and Leon Dugan.

The Papa Z's Mods rolled onto the track for their 25 lap main event, and for the first time all year they went green to checkers without a caution. Trevor Rocke picked up his second win of 2010 as he snuck away from the field to grab the win. The highlight of the race was the battle for second through 6th positions. Jason Sanville and Russell Christian raced side by side for several laps before Sanville slipped by in turn two for the second spot. Christian now had his hands full with Toby Stark, Tom Forward and Chris Chambers on his back bumper. Christian held on til the end to claim the third spot, followed by Stark and Forward. Chambers and Christian won their respective qualifiers.

The Northeast Waste Service Scone 360 Sprint Cars were out in force for their final point's race of 2010 at Canaan Dirt Speedway. This feature saw the leaders three wide off turn four for the white flag. When the checkers flew it was Tunk Berry edging out Chris Donnelly and Dan Douville for the win. Shawn Lawler placed fourth and secured the Canaan Speedway SCONE championship by six points over Chris Donnelly, and ten points over Dan Douville. Mark Cole finished the race in the fifth spot. Qualifying victories went to Donnelly and Nick Berry.

TC Forward won an exciting Beard Sewer and Drain Super Street main event. He was chased to the stripe by Ryan Christian, Troy Comeau, Todd Buckwold and Robbie Williams. Forward also won the qualifying event.

The Napa Mini Stock win went to Josh Sunn. Sunn held off a torrid charge by Leon Dugan for the victory. Brandon Lemere, Nathan Menard and Chris Cole completed the top five. Dugan won the heat race.

Leon Dugan held off Matt Boucher to claim victory in the Bond Auto Parts Bandit feature. Dallas Hammond, Mike Stender and Armand Boucher completed the top five. Matt Boucher won the lone qualifier.

Canaan Dirt Speedway will be right back in action this coming Friday night at 7pm as R.E. Hinkley Oil Company presents the evenings activities.
