

## **8-6-10 TREVOR ROCKE WINS FIRST ON CANAAN DIRT**

Dirt racing fans were treated to a great night of racing at Canaan Dirt Speedway as a good field of cars and a great crowd poured into the ¼ mile clay facility to enjoy all the night's activities presented by Route 118 Automotive. Winners on the night included Trevor Rocke, Tunk Berry, TC Forward, Josh Sunn and Dakota Stender.

Tunk Berry got out front early and never looked back as he survived one caution and a red flag situation to claim his first win at Canaan in 2010 in the Northeast Waste Services, SCONE Sprint Cars. The red flag came out on lap 6 as point leader Chris Donnelly tangled with a couple of cars and flipped hard in turn four. Donnelly's night was over and he fell back to a tie for 3rd place in the current CDS, SCONE point standings. Donnie Sharp, Kevin Chaffee, Dan Douville and Nick Berry completed the top five. Sharp and Berry snagged qualifying wins.

Papa Z's Modified s had a tremendous event as they were slowed for caution just three times. When the checkers flew, rookie driver, Trevor Rocke picked up his first career win after he survived a spirited battle with runner-up, Toby Stark. The pair raced side by side for a dozen laps before Rocke edged to the front and claimed the win. Jason Sanville raced home third, followed by Russell Christian and Tom Forward. Heat checkers flew for Dave Sanville and Forward.

The streak is over for Ryan Christian in the Beard Sewer and Drain Super Streets as he was denied his sixth win in a row. TC Forward got back on track after several sub-par weeks and scored a popular win. Will Hull raced home second, followed by Jason Giguere, Troy Comeau and Robbie Williams. Hull failed post race inspection with an engine that was out of spec thus moving everyone up a spot, and bumping Todd Buckwold to the 5<sup>th</sup> spot. Christian did capture the heat win.

Dakota Stender continues to dominate the Bond Auto Parts Bandits as he cruised to another victory over Leon Dugan, PJ Vaillancourt, Mike Stender and Dallas Hammond. Vaillancourt carried the preliminary checkers.

Josh Sunn won an exciting NAPA Mini Stock main, as he outgunned Mitchell Davis on a lap 10 restart and rolled to victory. Tim Hodge claimed the second spot ahead of Leon Dugan, David Dubeau and Davis. Davis cruised to victory in his qualifying round.

Canaan Dirt Speedway will be back in action this coming Friday night as LaValley Building Supply sponsors the night's activities.
