

3/8/2011 CANAAN FAIR SPEEDWAY'S GEARING UP FOR 2011

The 2011 race season may seem months away due to all the snow we have, but the pre-season hype is gearing up here at both the Canaan Dirt Speedway, and the "Awesome asphalt" at the historic Canaan Fair Speedways in Canaan, New Hampshire. These Speedways are quite unique as there is both a dirt track and an asphalt oval on the same grounds.

On the dirt side of things, an active off-season has kept management busy implementing innovative new sponsorship plans. Some plans are apparently so exciting; another local track has opted to copy them. Canaan Fair Dirt Speedway was the first to announce that a top ten finishing Modified competitor will walk away with a brand new 602 crate engine at the annual awards banquet of champions. Canaan Fair Speedway was the first to announce that its 2011 champion will receive a \$1,500 point fund check. Canaan Fair Dirt Speedway is also implementing purse increases in all divisions for 2011. Some special events on the dirt include a Triple Crown Series for the Mods. The SCoNE 360 Sprint Cars will return for a handful of events, plus the Granite State Mini-Sprints, and N.E. Mini-Sprints will be making numerous appearances in 2011. A large amount of early season entries have come in for the 2011 season as numerous new race teams are headed to Canaan in 2011.

Canaan Fair Dirt Speedway will also allow the DIRT car Hoosier tire at CDS this year, and they will also honor 2011 licenses from other tracks and series, thus allowing drivers and crewmembers discounts at the back gate. These are just a few of the money saving promotions that makes Canaan Dirt Speedway the choice for many Northeast dirt track racers.

On the asphalt side, numerous special events are on the schedule for 2011. First off, Canaan Speedway has teamed up with Lee USA Speedway for the new Pro Stock Six Pack Series. Both tracks will be offering three races, with healthy purses, and a solid point fund. The Pro All Stars Series will be in town along with Monster Trucks on the July 4th weekend. The biggest race in the history of Canaan Fair Speedway will take place on Saturday night, July 16th as the 2011 edition of Ricky's Race for Kids, Valenti Modified Racing Series hits the track. The event pays the winner a cool \$12,000. A huge field of Mods are expected to attempt to qualify for this event. On Saturday, August 20th, the popular ACT Tiger Sportsman Series returns. Last years event was one of the most exciting shows of the year.

Canaan Fair Speedway is also thinking of the race fans in 2011, as they announced recently the new Super Fan Card sponsored by Beard Sewer & Drain of Newport, New Hampshire. The Super Fan Card is available at both the dirt and asphalt tracks. Every time you present your Super Fan Card at the general admission booth, your card will get punched. When your card has accumulated ten punches you will receive a free general admission ticket redeemable at either track.

Make your plans to race, and be a super fan at Canaan Fair Speedways. General admission prices see no increase for 2011 and will remain at \$10 for adults, Jr. 10-16 and Seniors 62 and up are just \$8, kids 9 & under are free.
