

## **6/10/11 SANVILLE SCORES FIRST CANAAN DIRT WIN OF 2011**

Another great night of racing took place at the Canaan Dirt Speedway in Canaan, New Hampshire this past Friday night as over eighty cars filled the pit area, and another big crowd enjoyed another thrilling night of racing on Residence Inn Hanover / Lebanon night. Winners included Jason Sanville, Allan Hammond, Ryan Christian, Leon Dugan, Donnie Lashua, Dylan Manditto, and Lacey Hanson.

Jason Sanville finally got the monkey off his back by winning the 25 lap Papa Z's Modified feature event. Sanville, whom has suffered numerous mechanical problems all season long, took advantage of his front row starting spot to claim the win. The big battle was for the runner-up spot as second year driver, Chris Chambers had to battle race long with Trevor Rocke and Travis Shinn. When the checkers flew Chambers held on for second, Rocke third, Shinn fourth and Tom Forward rounded out the top five in the eighteen car field. Heat checkers flew for Chambers, Rocke and Nick Berry.

Allan Hammond got to the front early in the Mirror Lake Rod and Custom Late Models and never looked back. The event was plagued with cautions for minor spins and when the race ended Brad Shanks, Dan Collins, Dale Morse and Mike McClay completed the top five. Shanks grabbed the lone qualifier.

Ryan Christian continued his winning ways in the Beard Sewer & Drain Super Street nightcap. Christian had to hold off repeated challenges from Derek O'Hearn, Troy Comeau and Robbie Williams. Comeau ended up second followed by O'Hearn, Williams and JP Vaillaincourt. TC Forward and Williams won their respective qualifier.

Leon Dugan limped home with a heavily smoking engine in the Bond Auto Parts Bandits, narrowly edging out a fast closing Matt Boucher. Armand Boucher came home third, followed by Bill McKee and Doug Boucher. Dugan also claimed the qualifying win.

Donnie Lashua made a late race pass of Ryan Christian to grab the win in the NAPA Bomber Enduro main event. Cory Robert, AJ Vick and Clint Labine completed the top five.

The visiting Granite State Mini-Sprints were out in force in both the 500cc and 600 cc classes. Lacey Hanson was victorious in the 500's, while Dylan Manditto won the 600's.
