

## **7/8/11 TUCKER SURPRISES MODIFIED FIELD AT CANAAN DIRT SPEEDWAY**

It was a night of firsts at Canaan Dirt Speedway in Canaan, New Hampshire as Tim Tucker and JP Vaillancourt scored their first career wins in some very hotly contested races on LaValley Building Supply night. Joining them in victory lane were Allan Hammond, Bill McKee, Donnie Lashua, Billy Lussier and Matthew Robie.

Rookie driver Tim Tucker held off all eighteen challengers in the 25 lap Papa Z's Modified main event, proving that he is another driver that is showing great potential in this highly competitive division. Tucker grabbed the lead on a late race restart and held off Tom Forward til the checkers. Ed Tobin had a tremendous run and came home in the third spot followed by Allan Hammond and Dan Eastman. Trevor Roche, Ryan Avery, Robbie Lacroix, Joey Scarborough and Jason Giguere completed the top ten. The three heat checkers flew for Tucker, Chris Chambers and Roche.

Allan Hammond rolled to another victory in the Mirror Lake Rod & Custom Late Model main event. Hammond was followed by Brad Shanks, Dale Morse, Brian Sousa and Mike McClay. Shanks grabbed the lone qualifier.

Another rookie driver, JP Vaillancourt withstood an all out attack from Derek O'Hearn to grab his first career Beard Sewer & Drain Super Street win. O'Hearn dogged him over the final half of the race, but Vaillancourt was just quick enough to capture the win. Troy Comeau, Ryan Christian and Mark Brown rounded out the top five. O'Hearn and Comeau picked up qualifying victories.

Bill McKee took home the first place hardware in the Bond Auto Parts Bandits main. Armand Boucher, Tony Shaw, Leon Dugan and Dallas Hammond chased McKee to the finish. Armand Boucher won the heat race.

Another entertaining NAPA Bomber Enduro took place, and Donnie Lashua made it to victory lane for the second time this season. Cory Robert, AJ Vick, Mitchell Davis and Matt Lashua followed the winner til the end.

Billy Lussier won the 500cc Granite State Mini-Sprint main finishing ahead of Lacey Hanson and Kyle Belliveau. The 600cc checkers flew for Matthew Robie. He was followed by Dylan Menditto and Richard Crooker.
