SPECTATOR DRAGS & CHAIN RACES ADDED FOR THIS WEEK

Late day showers rolled into the Canaan Fair Speedway area late in the afternoon this past Friday forcing the season ending Shaker Valley Auto, Spencer Rocke Memorial event to be rescheduled for this coming Friday, September 30th, at 6:30pm.

The rescheduling of the event has allowed track management to add a couple of special events to the program. Along with the \$1,000 to win Modified event, \$300 to win Super Street / Limited Late Model challenge, \$150 to win Bandit / Bomber special, and Late Models, fans will see the return of Spectator Drags and those wild and wacky Chain Races from years gone by.

Spectator drags require that the car be registered, inspected and street legal. The racer needs to provide their own helmet. The winner will receive \$50. The rules for the Chain Races are simple. There will be two cars securely chained together with a ten foot chain or cable. The front car is the tow car and can be any type of street car or racecar. The back car has to be a four cylinder type car, and has to be the dead car meaning it can not run. The only thing it can have is steering and brakes. This race will pay \$100 to the winning team.
