

## **9/1/11 DOW, ROBINSON, O'HEARN AND BOUCHER PICK UP WINS ON CANAAN DIRT**

Kevin Chaffee cruised home in the second spot, while Dan Douville edged out Jim Lowrey Jr. for third. Tyler Rich rounded out the top five. Heat checkers flew for Mark Cole and Chaffee. By virtue of his third place finish, Dan Douville claimed the Canaan Fair Speedway SCoNE championship. Chris Donnelly finished second and was followed by Kevin Chaffee, Jim Lowrey Jr. and Clay Dow. These five drivers will be honored at the Annual Banquet of Champions scheduled for Friday night, November 4<sup>th</sup>.

DJ Robinson made a late race pass of leader Mark Williams in the Papa Z's Modifieds non-winner event and picked up his career first feature win. Tim Hodge rolled home in the third spot, followed by Kyle Johnson and Todd Patnode. Williams won the qualifying round.

Derek O'Hearn won a hotly contested Beard Sewer and Drain Super Street main event as Robbie Williams finished right on his rear bumper as the checkered flag flew. Ryan Christian, Mark Brown and JP Vaillancourt completed the top five.

It was a Boucher family reunion in the Bond Auto Parts Bandits winners circle as Armand Boucher held off repeated challenges from Matt Boucher. Doug Boucher placed third ahead of Dallas Hammond and Mark St. Pierre. Hammond won the lone qualifier.
